How to create healthy families through safe, stable and nurturing relationships.

## Safety

- Child: Children receive regular well checks and are in a safe environment.
- Caregiver: Caregivers are physically and mentally well and have healthy relationships and support systems.
- Community: The neighborhood is safe and the family has access to the resources they need.
- Policy: Federal and state laws ensure safety for ALL people.

## Stability

- Child: Children have consistent caregivers.
- Caregiver: Families are able to meet their basic needs.
- Community: There are adequate employment opportunities and affordable housing.
- Policy: Funding adequately provides resources to address factors.

## Nurturing

- Child: Children have positive interactions with their caregivers.
- Caregiver: Parents know child development and discipline strategies.
- Community: Communities collaborate to reduce stigma around families seeking help.
- Policy: Program policies are able to meet the needs of families in crisis.
